



REMI Demographic Data Projections



- Population and Labor Force Projections to 2060
- Data Sources:
 - The Census: National Projections of Fertility Rates, Survival Rates, Life Expectancy, International Migration, etc.
 - The BLS: Projections of Labor Force Participation Rates
 - The BEA: Population

BLS Employment Projections



- The baseline national forecast is primarily based on the BLS Employment Projections.
- Based on 2017 NAICS and derived from input-output data initially developed by the BEA.







- Effects of the Covid-19 pandemic
 - The Covid-19 pandemic caused a short but severe recession in 2020, which serves as the base year for the forecast.
 - Many industries will experience cyclical recovery from the Covid-19 recession in the short-term forecast, with industry output and employment normalizing and returning to their long-term growth pattern.
 - Structural change in the demand for some industries and occupations is expected as a result of economic changes driven by the pandemic. However, the pandemic's long-term impact remains highly uncertain.



BLS Employment Projections

2020-30



Employment growth rate: 0.7%



Labor force participation rate reduce from 61.7% in 2020 to 60.4% in 2030.



Real GDP increase at 2.3% annual growth rate.



Real output is projected to increase at 2.2% annual growth.



2019-29



Employment growth rate: 0.4%



Labor force participation rate reduce from 63.1% in 2019 to 61.2% in 2029.




Real GDP increase at 1.8% annual growth rate.



Real Output is projected to increase at 1.8% annual growth.




Population and labor force growth, 10-year compound annual average rates




Total Employment, 2000 to Projected 2030
